

#107 DAILY IN HIS PRESENCE
BLOOD COVENANT

While once yearly we observe the full meaning of our Lord in the Passover, remembering His death until He comes, Jesus also spoke of remembering the blood covenant of the cross often when we gather together to strengthen ourselves in the faith.

1 Corinthians 11:26 "For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come."

When the cares of the world weigh heavily upon you, Jesus knocks and calls for you to come to Him with repentant heart, to sup with Him, to hear His heart.

REVELATION 3:19-20 "As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent. Behold, I stand at the door, and knock:. If any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me."

PSALM 25:14 "The secret of the Lord is with them that fear him; and he will shew them his covenant."

Understand that the blood covenant God established with His children from the beginning, that requires confession of sins before receiving forgiveness through the shed blood of the Lamb, has not changed.

1 CORINTHIANS 11:27-30 "Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep."

A child of God today can no more dare enter into the presence of God without humbly confessing his sins to receive cleansing through the blood of Jesus, than an Israelite would dare to mock God by offering a lamb without first confessing his sins for which it was slain. Jesus waits knocking at the door of your heart, for you to humbly confess your sins for which He shed His blood, and receive His forgiveness.

1 JOHN 1:9 "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

1 JOHN 1:7 "But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son, cleanseth us from all sin."

The same God of Adam, and of Abraham and of Isaiah, manifest Himself in flesh in the body of our Lord Jesus Christ, His Son, to shed His own blood for our sins.

ISAIAH 43:10 11 "Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: that ye may know and believe me, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. ¹¹I, even I, am the LORD; and beside me there is no saviour."

PSALM 33:6 "By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth."

JOHN 1:14 "And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

ACTS 20:28 "Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood."

CLEANSING PRAYER

Thank you Jesus, that You are still the same loving, powerful God yesterday, today, and forever. Search my heart oh God. I confess to You my sins, and pray You cleanse me of every spot, so that nothing keeps me from hearing your voice. Lord Jesus, I humbly open the door and receive You in to sup with me.

JOHN 6:32-35 "Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world. Then they said unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread. And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth in me shall never thirst."

1 CORINTHIANS 11:23-24 "For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread: ²⁴and when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me."

EXODUS 25:30 "And thou shalt set upon the table showbread before me always."

RECEIVING THE BODY OF JESUS:

Thank you Jesus, for being broken for me, for giving all of yourself. May I be broken for you, and give you all my heart. As I take this bread, I receive the fullness of who You are into myself. Lord Jesus, I exchange my sin for Your holiness, and my weakness for Your mighty power, that You may be continually present and at work in me. Thank you for filling me, Jesus. May I always present the life-giving bread of your powerful presence on the table of my life.

EXODUS 12:13 “And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you.”

1 CORINTHIANS 11:25 “After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.”

PSALM 107:20 “He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.”

PSALM 103:2-3 “Bless the Lord, oh my soul, and forget not all his benefits: who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases.”

RECEIVING THE BLOOD OF JESUS:

Lord Jesus, I receive this cup and drink in, your new covenant with me. Thank you for forgiving me, washing me, and filling me with your presence and strength. I receive all your benefits of healing in my body and spirit. Thank you for healing me of every sin and disease through your blood that cleanses me and gives me life, Amen.

PHILIPPIANS 3:21 “Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.”

ROMANS 8:11 “But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.”

EPHESIANS 2:13 “But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.”

PHILIPPIANS 3:13,14 “Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.”

II CORINTHIANS 3:18 “But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.”

COVENANT PRAYER:

Thank you, my Father, for drawing me near to Yourself, for healing me, for filling me, flowing through me and covering me, and immersing me with Yourself. Thank you that I do not have to worry about being strong enough because You are able, and it is your life in me, that strengthens me and carries me to where you want me to go. Thank you for the hope of your power at work in me that changes me to be like you. Thank you, Jesus, that right now, I can stand completely cleansed, healed and holy before you, and able to press forward to victory in my life, because you are holy and alive in me. May I bring honor and glory to your name in all that I am, and in all that I do. In Jesus name, amen.

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
