SCRIPTURE READING *(Read Aloud Together)*

Deuteronomy 30:19

“I call heaven and earth to record this day against you,
that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing:
therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live.”

Joshua 1:9

“Have not I commanded thee? Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.”

1. INTRODUCTION: Joshua sent spies into the land of Canaan to look over the land. The spies stayed with Rahab who was a prostitute, showing us, that no matter what you have done, God will forgive you and use your life for His glory. Rahab believed in the God of the Israelites and God used her to help the spies to escape. God told her through the spies, if she would put the red cord in her window that when they came back to destroy the city of Jericho, God would spare her life and all those she brought into her house. Rahab believed God's word. When you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, and the blood that He shed on the cross to pay the penalty for your sin, God sees your faith and saves you for all eternity.

2. AFTER THE SPIES RETURNED, THE ISRAELITES MOVED ON TO CAMP ON THE BANKS OF THE JORDAN.

Joshua 3:1 “*And Joshua rose early in the morning; and they removed from Shittim, and **came to Jordan, he and all the children of Israel, and lodged there before they passed over.***”



Coming to the border of the Promised Land that had eluded them for 40 long years would be both exciting and terrifying at the same time. Remember that their parents had died in the wilderness, there were giants in the land, and there were armies waiting to attack them! Yet

four times since Moses had died, God repeated the same message:

Joshua 1:9 “*Have not I commanded thee? **Be strong and of a good courage; be not afraid, neither be thou dismayed: for the LORD thy God is with thee whithersoever thou goest.***”

God’s word to us is the same as God told Joshua and the Israelites. Jesus dwells in you, and tells you to have courage and not be afraid or discouraged, because God Himself is with you wherever you go!

John 14:23 “*Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and **we will come unto him, and make our abode with him.***”

While God promises to go with us, He also commanded the Israelites, and He commands us: **Wait for His presence to go before us and get ourselves out of the way!**

Joshua 3:3-4 “*And they commanded the people, saying, When ye see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests the Levites bearing it, then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it. ⁴Yet there shall be a space between you and it, about two thousand cubits by measure: come not near unto it, **that ye may know the way by which ye must go: for ye have not passed this way heretofore.***”


God was leading them, just as God still leads us, into enemy territory where we have not been before. **Wait for the Lord and follow.**

3. THE PEOPLE PROMISE TO OBEY GOD AND TO FOLLOW JOSHUA LIKE THEY HAD FOLLOWED MOSES.

Before the Israelites camped beside the Jordan, remember that they had committed themselves to obey God and to follow Joshua.

Joshua 1:16-18 “And they answered Joshua, saying, All that thou commandest us we will do, and whithersoever thou sendest us, we will go. ¹⁷ According as we hearkened unto Moses in all things, so will we hearken unto thee: only the LORD thy God be with thee, as he was with Moses. ¹⁸ Whosoever he be that doth rebel against thy commandment, and will not hearken unto thy words in all that thou commandest him, he shall be put to death: only be strong and of a good courage.”

God’s people promised to obey everything God said. How very much they were just like us today - how often do we promise God that we will do everything He asks us to do, then unfairness, or tragedy happen, or too much work gets in the way, and we forget. But even when we forget what God has done, God is always faithful!



Deuteronomy 29:5 “And I have led you forty years in the wilderness: your clothes are not waxen old upon you, and thy shoe is not waxen old upon thy foot.”

God had supernaturally preserved their clothing and sandals, and gave manna from heaven and quail to eat for all the 40 years they wandered complaining against Him in the desert, until He brought them to the Promised Land. This was going to be the last time that God would send them manna from heaven to gather for the journey:

Joshua 1:10 “Then Joshua commanded the officers of the people, saying, ¹¹ Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals; for within three days ye shall pass over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God giveth you to possess it.”

The people had three days to gather the manna God provided, and to wash themselves in preparation to enter the land God had given.

4. JOSHUA PREPARES THE PEOPLE TO ENTER INTO THE PROMISED LAND.

Joshua 3:2 & 5 “And it came to pass after three days, that the officers went through the host...⁵ And Joshua said unto the people, Sanctify yourselves: for to morrow the LORD will do wonders among you.”

Joshua told his officers to go through the camp, commanding God’s people to set themselves apart wholly unto God. It is still true today, that when we sanctify ourselves, by repenting of sin and setting ourselves apart for God, He works wonders among us!

Joshua 3:6 “And Joshua spake unto the priests, saying, Take up the ark of the covenant, and pass over before the people. And they took up the ark of the covenant, and went before the people.”

Most of the year, the Jordan River was about 100 feet wide and only three to ten feet deep; however, when the Israelites crossed during harvest season, it was at flood stage from the melting snows of Mt. Hermon, about 300-360 feet wide and 10 to 24 feet deep.

“In the deeply sunken, tropical valley of the Jordan, the harvest had already commenced, and the snow on Hermon having begun to melt, the “yellow” water of the river stood high and had overflowed its lower bank. “We were on the banks of the Jordan.... Muddy, swollen, and turbid, the stream was far too formidable and rapid for the most adventurous to attempt their intended bathe... By measurement we found that the river had lately been fourteen feet higher than its present margin, and yet it was still many feet above its ordinary level.” Tristram’s Land of Israel, p. 223.

Numbers 26:51 “These were the numbered of the children of Israel, six hundred thousand and a thousand seven hundred and thirty.”

Only sons were numbered, so here stood, with each son having wives and 2-3 children, at least 2 ½ to 3 ½ million people, waiting to cross, but the Jordan River was impossible to cross. Nothing but the mighty hand of God could have made this deep and rapidly flowing river safe for His people. Many things in life are impossible to do on our own but God will show us how.



5. GOD TESTS HIS PEOPLE BEFORE THE MIRACLE.



The golden Ark of the Covenant was a symbol of God's presence among His people. They knew that God came to meet with Moses between the wings of the angels on the mercy seat of the Ark, and they believed His promise to also be with them. Of course they were terrified to go into those waters, but Joshua told the priests to walk in and stand still in the waters.

*Joshua 3:7-13 "And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that, as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee. ⁸ And **thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan.** ⁹ And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, Come hither, and hear the words of the LORD your God. ¹⁰ And **Joshua said, Hereby ye shall know that the living God is among you,** and that he will without fail drive out from before you the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Hivites, and the Perizzites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Jebusites. ¹¹ **Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord of all the earth passeth over before you into Jordan.** ¹² Now therefore take you twelve men out of the tribes of Israel, out of every tribe a man. ¹³ **It shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, that the waters of Jordan shall be cut off from the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap.**"*

The people moved back and watched the priests carry the Ark of God through the camp and nothing happened until they stood still before God in the river Jordan...would they drown?

*Psalm 46:10 "**Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.**"*

When in the midst of stormy waters, God asks us to be still and trust Him, until we are at peace. When troubles are all around you, stand on His word, then be still, and trust God, because He is God.

6. WHEN WE ARE STILL, WE TRUST THAT GOD IS GOD.

Everything we lose in this world we lose through fear that knocks out our footing so we are no longer grounded with our faith in God. We may not have a River Jordan to cross, but we have storms come when we must stand our ground in faith and be still until God moves. If we will not be still and trust God, then the thief steals the promise.

John 10:10 “The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have *it more abundantly.*”

OBJECT LESSON: Toothpick and Nail.

When we look at all the giant problems and challenges around us, we're kind of small and weak like this toothpick. If we try to stand up to our giant problems on our own, those giant problems can just snap us in to pieces (snap toothpick in half without breaking it). But Jesus loves you so much. When you ask Him to be your Savior and come into your heart, He comes in to your life and never ever leaves you! Jesus wants to heal you and cleanse you (carefully straighten toothpick beside the nail and rubberband them together) and makes you whole again, and promises to go with you where ever you go! When a giant problem comes along (try to snap the toothpick and strike the nail on the table but the toothpick will not break), hold closely to Jesus and be still until He moves and follow Him, for only He will make you strong!

Ephesians 3:14-19 “For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, ¹⁵ of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, ¹⁶ that he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; ¹⁷ that Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; ¹⁹ and to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fulness of God.”

What frightens you? Is it doubt, fear, need, fighting, unbelief? Be still and know God is with you, listen with your heart and He will help you. The River Jordan did not part until the priests stood in the stormy waters with both feet, trusting that God is God!



7. GOD MAKES A WAY WHEN THERE IS NO WAY.



Joshua told His people that as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests stood in the water, that the river would part and the flow of water would stand up in a heap! Don't be afraid of what might happen to you and let the devil steal away God's promise; believe that God **will** take you through safely and He will!

Eph 3:20 "Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us."


Jesus wants you to stand in faith as a testimony that HE IS ABLE! What would happen if the priests could not get over their fear enough to trust God by placing their feet in the Jordan and standing firm? Don't let the devil steal away what God has given to you!

Joshua 3:14-17 "And it came to pass, when the people removed from their tents, to pass over Jordan, and the priests bearing the ark of the covenant before the people; ¹⁵ and as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,) ¹⁶ that the waters which came down from above stood and rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that is beside Zaretan: and those that came down toward the sea of the plain, even the salt sea, failed, and were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho. ¹⁷ And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan."

As soon as the feet of the priests carrying the Ark stood in the water, it parted! The waters coming down the river just stood right up in a heap, because the priests obeyed God, standing in the river on the dry ground trusting Him! Don't ever be afraid to stand up for Jesus! Every last Israelite passed over on dry ground! Do you think the priests and Israelites knew for sure that God would do it for them? No, but He did - and He'll do it for you! **When do our stormy waters part? When we trust God and follow Him!**

8. GOD'S PEOPLE BUILD A MONUMENT OF PRAISE TO HIM AS A MEMORIAL TO HIS POWER AND GOODNESS.

Joshua 4:1-9 “And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over Jordan, that the Lord spake unto Joshua, saying, 2 Take you twelve men out of the people, out of every tribe a man, 3 and command ye them, saying, Take you hence out of the midst of Jordan, out of the place where the priests’ feet stood firm, twelve stones, and ye shall carry them over with you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night. 4 Then Joshua called the twelve men, whom he had prepared of the children of Israel, out of every tribe a man: 5 and Joshua said unto them, Pass over before the ark of the Lord your God into the midst of Jordan, and take you up every man of you a stone upon his shoulder, according unto the number of the tribes of the children of Israel: 6 that this may be a sign among you, that when your children ask their fathers in time to come, saying, What mean ye by these stones? 7 then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the Lord; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever. 8 And the children of Israel did so as Joshua commanded, and took up twelve stones out of the midst of Jordan, as the Lord spake unto Joshua, according to the number of the tribes of the children of Israel, and carried them over with them unto the place where they lodged, and laid them down there. 9 And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests which bare the ark of the covenant stood: and they are there unto this day.”



After every person passed over on dry ground while the priests stood still with the Ark of God, Joshua called one man from each tribe, to carry a large stone, and lay the 12 stones down on the Promised Land side of the Jordan as a monument to God’s faithfulness to cut off the stormy flood waters when we call upon His name!

1 Thessalonians 5:23-25 “And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. ²⁴ Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it. ²⁵ Brethren, pray for us.”

9. STAND FIRM IN THE MIDST OF TROUBLE & WATCH THE LORD PART THE WATERS TO KEEP YOU SAFE.

Then Joshua took 12 stones from the wilderness side of the river and set them in the riverbed where the priests stood on dry ground. These stones represented their old life of sin, all behind them now with their new life ahead in the Promised Land!



Joshua 4:10-18

“For the priests which bare the ark stood in the midst of Jordan, until every thing was finished that the Lord commanded Joshua to speak unto the people, according to all that Moses

*commanded Joshua: and the people hasted and passed over. 11 And it came to pass, **when all the people were clean passed over, that the ark of the Lord passed over, and the priests, in the presence of the people.** 12 And the children of Reuben, and the children of Gad, and half the tribe of Manasseh, passed over **armed before the children of Israel, as Moses spake unto them:** 13 **about forty thousand prepared for war passed over before the Lord unto battle,** to the plains of Jericho. 14 On that day the Lord magnified Joshua in the sight of all Israel; and they feared him, as they feared Moses, all the days of his life. 15 And the Lord spake unto Joshua, saying, 16 **Command the priests that bear the ark of the testimony, that they come up out of Jordan.** 17 Joshua therefore commanded the priests, saying, **Come ye up out of Jordan.** 18 **And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the Lord were come up out of the midst of Jordan, and the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as they did before.**”*

The 12 stones from the wilderness side were buried beneath the waters of the Jordan, just as our sins are buried with Christ in the waters of baptism! The priests stood firm, until everything God commanded was done. Then as soon as their feet lifted up onto dry ground, the river flooded its banks as it did before! When you are standing in the midst of a storm, stand firm in God, and know that He is able to part the waters, and keep the storm from touching you, until His will be done and you pass through.

10. ALWAYS SPEAK OF THE MEMORIALS OF THE POWER OF ALMIGHTY GOD THAT WE MAY FEAR THE LORD FOR EVER.

It was the day that the lambs for Passover were to be selected on the tenth day of the first month, when God brought His people up out of the river Jordan, and they camped in Gilgal on the east border of Jericho. Gilgal literally means “circle of stones” These stones are the 12 stones still standing today as monument beside the Jordan.



Joshua 4:19-24. "And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth day of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho. ²⁰ And those twelve stones, which they took out of Jordan, did Joshua pitch in Gilgal. ²¹ And he spake unto the children of Israel, saying, When your children shall ask their fathers in time to come, saying, What mean these stones? ²² then ye shall let your children know, saying, Israel came over this Jordan on dry land. ²³ For the LORD your God dried up the waters of Jordan from before you, until ye were passed over, as the LORD your God did to the Red sea, which he dried up from before us, until we were gone over: ²⁴ that all the people of the earth might know the hand of the LORD, that it is mighty: that ye might fear the LORD your God for ever.."

Joshua built a monument out of those 12 large stones as a memorial to their children and all who looked at it, to remember the miracle God had done. In these last days before the coming of the Lord, it is more and more important that we stand firmly in the ways of God, and witness of the goodness of the Lord!

Jeremiah 6:16 "Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls...."

2 Peter 3:1-3 "This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: ² that ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour: ³ knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts."

11. STAND ON THE WHOLE WORD OF GOD IN THESE CONFUSING TIMES OF THE LAST DAYS BEFORE JESUS.

As the scripture said, we live in the last days before the coming of the Lord Jesus, when many Churches are teaching that the Old Testament was only for the hard-hearted Jews who killed Jesus, but is that what the Bible teaches? NO! The New Testament teaches that every word was written for us today - testify of every word!

Luke 4:3-4 “And the devil said unto him, If thou be the Son of God, command this stone that it be made bread. ⁴ And Jesus answered him, saying, It is written, That man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God.”

When their children and all future generations asked the meaning of the stones, the Israelites would tell them again of the power of the mighty God who brought them through the flooded River Jordan on dry land so that all the people of the earth would reverence the Lord God of heaven forever! Build a monument of praise to Jesus by proclaiming all He has done for you, and stand upon His word! John testified that the very same God who held back the waters of the Jordan, came to earth as the Messiah, and it is He who lives in you:

1 John 4:2-4 “Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of God: ³ and every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world. ⁴ Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.”


Paul and John spoke of the heresy being taught today, as nothing new, but was in fact being taught by the Anti Christ who was already at work among God’s people, accusing the apostle Paul of heresy! So how shall we overcome anti-Christ doctrine that spreads like a cancer?

Revelation 12:11 “And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.”

Acts 24:14 “But this I confess unto thee, that after the way which they call heresy, so worship I the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the law and in the prophets.”

12. GOD'S PURPOSE & PLAN FOR ME

1. We may not keep our promise to God when we are too busy or we are afraid, but God is always faithful to those who love Him.
2. Before God works mighty works among His people, we must still repent of our sin, and sanctify ourselves wholly for Him.
3. God will always test the faith of His people before the miracle.
4. When you are in the midst of troubled waters, be still until you are at peace with God, until you can trust that God is God.
5. When God leads us into enemy territory where we have not been before, step out of the way, and wait, then follow His presence.
6. God wants us to be responsible for the miracles He has done, to make memorials, and tell everyone of His mighty works!
7. When the road ahead is impossible, don't complain. In the hard times, listen and follow the presence of the Lord. Stand while God accomplishes in you all that He created you to be - then watch Him make a way for you where there is no way!
8. Allow the Lord Jesus to completely cleanse you from all sin. Jesus in you wants to do wonderful, amazing things in your life!
9. Bring glory to God and victory to your life by choosing to build an altar of praise. Tell everyone of the goodness of Jesus who loves you and blesses you!
10. God makes a way through the impossible when there is no way.



Dear Father God, Thank you for bringing me through troubled waters again and again, and for all you have given me. In hard times help me stand close with you, trusting not in myself, but in your strength. Help me remember to praise you for your goodness as I watch you do amazing things in my life, *In Jesus name, Amen.*

CHILDREN'S SECTION

(10-15 minutes)

1. Sing 2 or 3 children's songs relating to the story.
2. Tell children a brief exciting summary of Bible story as you give them the coloring page, relating God's mighty power to save His people, with God's love and power in their lives.
3. Read the Children's Story aloud, making it real to them.
4. Show them the exciting craft they will be making, tying in God's purpose for their lives.
5. Congregation sings, "The Animals Go Marching" song, as the young children are marched over to "Noah's Ark".
6. Congregation has fellowship time, before beginning adult worship, followed by ministry of the Bible lesson booklet.

14. CHILDREN'S STORY: Rachel's Dilemma



Rachel was a Christian and wanted to be happy, but she had a problem that was making her miserable! Rachel had been praying every single day that Jesus would make that mean boy Kenny, be nice to her, “Why doesn’t Jesus answer my prayer?” thought Rachel. Kenny played mean tricks on her like putting worms in her lunch, and telling his friends to call her awful names! Sometimes no one would talk to her and Rachel just couldn’t take it anymore.

Rachel told everybody how horrible Kenny was hoping that he would stop. She complained to her friends and her teachers, but still nothing changed. Why wouldn’t they do anything? Rachel didn’t know what to do. At church, Miss Nancy, her Children’s Church teacher asked who needed prayer. Rachel raised her hand but felt her situation was hopeless. Miss Nancy asked Rachel to stay after class and asked her, “Rachel, have you felt better since you started complaining against Kenny every day?” Rachel thought it over, “No, the more I complain the worse things get. But what is the answer Miss Nancy? I know that Jesus wants me to be happy, but I feel more and more miserable every day! What should I do?” Miss Nancy answered, “Rachel, God’s word says that as long as you choose to complain you will wander around in unhappiness and not have the happy abundant life that Jesus promises for you. Instead of asking God how to make Kenny stop being mean, ask God how you can help Kenny.” Rachel sputtered in surprise, “Why?” Miss Nancy answered, “Because he is sinning against you. What did Jesus do when He was beaten and nailed to the cross? Did Jesus ask the Father to make them stop being so mean when the mean men nailed Him to the cross?” Rachel was amazed, “No, Miss Nancy, Jesus asked God to forgive them. I understand, I should be like Jesus ask God to forgive Kenny, and then I will tell him about Jesus!”

Rachel prayed for Kenny, and it was hard, but she told him she was sorry she had said mean things about him. He was so shocked he didn’t say a word! It wasn’t very long before Kenny came up to Rachel at school and asked her, “What happened Rachel? Why are you so nice to me when I’ve been so mean to you?” Rachel told him, “I can be kind to you because Jesus has forgiven me. He loves me, and He loves you too, Kenny.” Kenny asked, “Would Jesus forgive me too, Rachel?” “Of course He will!” Said Rachel, “You can ask Him to be your Savior too!” And Kenny did! God made a miracle for Rachel when she chose to tell of His praises.

15. GOSPEL CRAFT: Blessing Stones Of Remembrance


Directions:

1. Fold blue card stock in thirds lengthwise & cut waves into outside edges.
2. Cut brown card stock into thirds and glue to center section of the Jordan.
3. Cut out Scripture and Purpose Strips & Glue to outside of Waves.
4. Fold outside edges to center and glue Goldfish crackers to outside.
5. Cut out 12 blessing stones of remembrance and glue onto the dry land.
6. Fold outside edges over the top of blessing stones.
7. Open the stormy waters to see the stones and remember your blessings!

Activity:

Build altars out of miniature marshmallows on a graham cracker, using peanut butter for the mortar to hold the "stones" together.
