GOD’S PURPOSE FOR ME

**GOD IS FAITHFUL TO KEEP HIS PROMISES
WHEN I TRUST HIS WAY, AND GO WHERE HE BLESSES!**

INTRODUCTION: Before the foundation of the earth, God our Savior knew that the man He created would sin, and provided a way of redemption. Adam and Eve taught their children that only the blood of a spotless lamb could save them from their sins, because the lamb was a substitute until God Himself would come to redeem His people. People became more and more evil until God decided man must be destroyed to cleanse the earth, but there was a righteous man who walked with God - Noah! Noah preached the Gospel for 100 years while the world laughed until the judgment of the flood came, and the door was shut. The day is coming when the world will be cleansed by fire at the coming of the Lord. Jesus is the open door, calling everyone to come and be saved! We must preach the Gospel like Noah, to come to Jesus and be saved before it is too late.

2. LIFE PARABLE: Get On Board and Follow the Program!



Jeanie and Bobby were good friends and they both loved Jesus. But Jeanie got good grades while Bobby complained that the teacher didn't like him. Bobby said he didn't understand the work so it was not his fault that he got bad grades, but when Jeanie didn't understand something, she looked through her book to find the answer. Jeanie always did all her homework, but Bobby said he didn't take his books home because they were too heavy! When it came time for the track race Jeanie practiced every day and won the race, but Bobby said he was not going to practice, because the other kids were faster and he knew he wouldn't win anyway. Bobby was always complaining, but Jeanie kept praying for him.

One day Bobby told Jeanie he wished he was faster and smarter, and that God would bless him like God blessed Jeanie. Jeanie was surprised, and said, ***“Oh Bobby, Jesus loves you just as much as He loves me and He will bless you! The Bible tells us how to have good success at anything we want to do: Like if we want to get good grades then we have to follow the directions for how to get good grades! And if we want to win at anything, then we have to follow the directions for winning first, and practice if we want to win!”***

“Bobby, it's kind of like if you follow the directions for making cookies, then you will get some good cookies! But if you don't follow the directions and just mix in whatever you want and leave stuff out, then you can't expect to get good cookies. So if you want life to be sweet then you have to put in what God says is good!” Bobby thought a minute and then he understood. ***“I think I'll take my books home and study so I can get good grades too!”*** Jeanie smiled seeing that Bobby was choosing God's way, knowing God would be faithful to keep His promises and bless Bobby too!

Noah had to follow the program and get on board before God gave him the blessing. When nothing seems to go right, does it mean God's promises are not true for you? We must examine ourselves: **Have we followed God's directions for success? Let's be like Noah and obey God's word so we don't miss the boat!**

3. GOD KEPT NOAH AND HIS FAMILY SAFE IN THE ARK DURING THE STORM.

Genesis 7:11-20 “In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened. ¹² And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights.



¹³ In the selfsame day entered Noah, and Shem, and Ham, and Japheth, the sons of Noah, and Noah's wife, and the three wives of his sons with them, into the ark; ¹⁴ They, and every beast after his kind, and all the cattle after their kind, and every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind, and every fowl after his kind, every bird of every sort. ¹⁵ And they went in unto Noah into the ark, two and two of all flesh, wherein is the breath of life. ¹⁶ And they that went in, went in male and female of all flesh, as God had commanded him: and the LORD shut him in.”

The majority of Christians today say that God’s way is just loving everyone, and laugh at those who obey God’s Commandments, just like they laughed at Noah. When we obey God and come into Him, He shuts us in, safe with Him from the storm of sin going on outside.

Genesis 7:11-20 “The flood was forty days upon the earth; and the waters increased, and bare up the ark, and it was lift up above the earth. ¹⁸ And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters. ¹⁹ And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills, that were under the whole heaven, were covered. ²⁰ Fifteen cubits upward did the waters prevail; and the mountains were covered.”

A cubit is the measurement from the forearm to the tip of the middle finger so that each mans cubit is a different size. To solve this problem in Ancient times the universal cubit would be the length of the kings cubit... The distance between thumb and another finger to the elbow on an average person measures about 24 digits or 6 palms or 1½ feet...This "natural cubit" of 1½ feet is used in the Roman system of measures and in different Greek systems. – Wikipedia

4. GOD TEACHES US WISDOM THROUGH HARDSHIPS.

In the book, “**Everything I need to know about life I learned from Noah’s Ark**”, the “Unknown Author” gives very sound advice:

ONE - Don’t miss the boat.

TWO - Remember that we are all in the same boat.

THREE - Plan ahead. It wasn’t raining when Noah built the Ark.

FOUR - Stay fit, because when you’re 600 years old, someone may ask you to do something really big.

FIVE - Don’t listen to critics; just do the job that needs to be done.

SIX - For safety’s sake, travel in pairs.

SEVEN - Speed isn’t always an advantage. The turtles were on board with the cheetahs.

EIGHT - When you’re stressed, float a while.

NINE - Remember the Ark was built by amateurs; the Titanic was built by professionals.

TEN - No matter how terrible the storm, when you travel with Jesus, there is always a rainbow waiting!

Genesis 7:24 “And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.”

Rain beat against the ark for forty days while the floods covered the earth to about 22 ½ feet above the tallest mountain (*15 cubits times 1 ½ feet*). After forty days of rain, the waters covered the earth for one year and ten days. There in the darkness of the Ark, Noah and his family were saved from the judgment of water that cleansed the earth, while all other living things were destroyed suddenly and completely in the flood! They must have had some mixed feelings.



Sometimes life can feel overwhelming when we are in a dark place feeling forgotten by God. Remember, God did not speak audibly to Noah every day! Surely Noah had many uncertain days of wondering. He had to just obey and follow through on faith, just like we do! We cannot know what the end of our dilemma will be, but we can know for certain that when we read God’s word and obey what we do know, that He will be there with a blessing when the storm passes over, God is faithful!

5. STRATA OF THE EARTH WAS FORMED IN THE YEAR THAT WATER COVERED THE EARTH.

If the global Flood, as described in Genesis 7-8 really occurred, what evidence would we expect to find? Wouldn't we expect to find rock layers all over the earth that are filled with billions of dead animals and plants that were rapidly buried and fossilized in sand, mud, and lime? Yes, and that's exactly what we find! The fossil-bearing geologic record consists of tens of thousands of feet of sedimentary layers...such as about 4,500 feet of strata in the walls of the Grand Canyon.

Uniformitarian (long-age) geologists believe that these sedimentary layers were deposited and deformed over the past 500 million years. If it really did take millions of years, then individual sediment layers would have been deposited slowly and the sequences would have been laid down sporadically. In contrast, if the global cataclysmic Genesis Flood deposited all these strata in a little more than a year, then the individual layers would have been deposited in rapid succession, one on top of the other. Do we see evidence in the walls of the Grand Canyon that the sedimentary layers were all laid down in quick succession? Yes, absolutely! The theory evolutionists teach as fact, that these hard brittle layers of rock strata were formed over millions of years and then gradually folded, is not possible, because rock does not fold - it breaks!

6. SCIENTISTS AGREE DINOSAUR FOSSILS WERE PRESERVED BY SUDDEN BURIAL IN A FLOOD.

The last of the dinosaurs were supposed to have died off about 65-100 million evolutionary years ago. One of the greatest dinosaur collections in the world is at China's Zigong Dinosaur Museum. Scientist Rick Gore, when visiting this Museum wrote: "This site of mass death, probably from flooding, records the surge of gigantism in the middle Jurassic. Dong and I carefully descend to the mudstone floor and walk amid a petrified forest of bones." [4]



One recent A&E television program (Voyages, December 23, 1995) discussed a herd of fossilized Centrosaurus dinosaurs, which were similar to triceratops, found in the Gobi desert of Mongolia. The evolutionists could only come up with one reasonable explanation as to how all of these great beasts could possibly have died at one and the same time and place, and then been buried and preserved together. A flood. Of course it was not to be considered that this could have in any way been connected with the world-wide flood of Noah, which would explain everything very well, since mass graves of dinosaur remains are found in nearly every part of the globe, while even evolutionists acknowledge that it was a world-wide catastrophe that caused the demise of the dinosaurs.

7. ADULT DINOSAURS AND THEIR EGGS WERE PRESERVED BY SUDDEN BURIAL IN NOAH'S FLOOD.

Could any of this be explained by uniformitarianism? With normal sedimentary processes, even fish don't normally form fossils when they die; they float to the surface and are devoured by other fish, bacteria, and by the action of the elements. Yet we find great numbers of fossil fish buried together in many parts of the world, in quite a few cases buried with the dinosaurs, right along with the bones of mammals, birds, and the remains of insects.

Voyages also dealt with a huge number of dinosaur eggs that were found in the Gobi desert, yet the shells had not been damaged, simply buried and fossilized. In attempting to fathom what



force of nature could have killed the mothers and preserved the eggs at the same time, perhaps not wishing to waver too close to the Biblical account, they suggested that a sudden sandstorm or a sand dune falling on these beasts caused their death and preservation. [5] (Recently new evidence has turned up that has contradicted this view, and it has now been presumed that they were suddenly buried by the action of water and sediment.)

The huge sedimentary action necessary for the death and burial of such large numbers of giant beasts would not occur in normal hydraulic action in river currents in sufficient intensity and scope to preserve the vast fossil graveyards that exist. Rivers don't generally bury such large numbers of animals together; their carcasses are carried downstream where they are eventually deposited along the shoreline somewhere. The process that created the vast dinosaur fossil graveyards would require a flood of truly monumental proportions.

8. GOD PROVIDES A WAY TO KEEP US SAFE THROUGH SCARY STORMS OUTSIDE AND FROM STORMS INSIDE.

Yes, most of the animals died, but God brought the dinosaurs along with every kind of animal He created and kept them safe on the Ark.

Genesis 6:14 *“Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.”*

How is the pitch on the ark like the comfort of the Holy Spirit Jesus gives to us?



Luke 4:18; Isaiah 61:1 *“The Spirit of the Lord God is upon me; because the Lord hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; He hath sent me to bind up the broken-hearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound.”*

The storms of life can be very frightening. God knows, He sees, and gives His Holy Spirit to cover, to heal, to teach and comfort and deliver from fear of present danger, and from bondages that keep us imprisoned in our past, so we can enjoy a full abundant life in Him.

John 10:10 *“The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.”*

OBJECT VISUAL: Cookie Man or Cracker, Frosting, Knife

(Slowly patch a cookie man with white frosting as you tell the narration:)

- *Jesus came to heal up all the holes and wounds in our lives just like the pitch that patched and protected the ark from the storms.*
- *Jesus gives us His Holy Spirit like the pitch that patched the Ark, to protect us from the storms that hit our lives.*
- *His Holy Spirit comes inside your heart, to fill all the places that are hurting or that aren't quite perfect, then He immerses you in Himself to protect you on the outside, and makes our life sweet!*
- *Jesus came to fill you, protect you and to give you a life full of happiness and real peace that does not pass away.*



9. IN NOAH'S DAY SALVATION WAS PREACHED UNTIL THE EARTH WAS SUDDENLY CLEANSED BY WATER.

Noah preached salvation to the wicked, hoping they would come into the Ark and be saved from the flood, but they would not listen. Only Noah and his family were saved, while destruction came suddenly for those left behind.



Genesis 7:21-23 *“And all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man: ²² All in whose nostrils was the breath of life, of all that was in the dry land, died. ²³ And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: **and Noah only remained alive, and they that were with him in the ark.**”*

Jesus calls us to preach the Gospel of salvation calling all men to come to Him and be saved from the destruction that is coming by fire! Most do not believe that God would do such a thing, and do not believe that God really sent a flood that killed a world full of people and all living things that were not on the Ark, but Jesus and His disciples taught that it is true, and it will come to pass!

2 Peter 3:3-7 *“...in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, and saying, Where is the promise of his coming? For **since the fathers fell asleep**, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation, for this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and **in the water**: **Whereby the world that then was, perished.** But **the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment** and perdition of ungodly men.”*



Just as in the days of Noah, those who will not come to Jesus for salvation will perish, but this time the wicked left behind will be burned when the earth is cleansed by fire.

The Day of the Lord is coming, find the lost and bring them in!

10. SALVATION IS PREACHED UNTIL JESUS' COMING WHEN THE EARTH WILL BE CLEANSED BY FIRE.

2 Peter 3:10-12 *“But **the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night**; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, **the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up**...Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein **the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat?**”*



God is calling to salvation but so many have been deceived by Satan's lies, and close their ears so they will not hear. We often hear of peace promised through the meditations of Buddhism and other New Age religions but peace is fleeting because it is a self-focused religion, **seeking after a temporary feeling of peaceful bliss.**

1 Thessalonians 5:2-3 *“For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night. ³ For **when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.**”*

The Public School system deceives millions of children to leave God for evolution and seek a false peace that invites false spirits through the practice of Yoga, but as is clearly seen, since 1960 as God was gradually replaced by evolution and meditation, they have no peace.

Matthew 24:37-42 *“But **as the days of Noah were, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be.** For as in the days that were before the flood they were **eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered into the ark, and knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be**...Watch therefore: for ye know not what hour your Lord doth come.”*

Those left behind in Noah's day had no second chance to hear the Gospel because sudden destruction came upon them. The same consequence awaits those who are left behind at the coming day of the Lord for they will be burned at His coming! The coming of the Lord to catch believers up to heaven will come suddenly while fire falls upon unbelievers with no warning – just as in the days of Noah.

11. GOD'S PROMISE OF SALVATION & IMMORTALITY IS AT HIS COMING FOR ALL WHO BELIEVE ON HIM.

God called everybody alive in the 100 years of Noah's preaching, to come in to the Ark to be saved, yet everyone was not saved. Why? They refused to receive Him. Is it God's will that some be lost? No! God is longsuffering and not willing that anyone should perish!

2 Peter 3:9 *"The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, **not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.**"*

1 Timothy 2:3-4 *"For this is good and acceptable in the sight of **God our Saviour; Who will have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth.**"*



1 Peter 1:2 *"**Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father....**"*

God knows who will receive Him and become elect for salvation at His coming, and He knows who will be lost. God knew the people of Noah's day would drown in the flood before it happened, but He did not choose for them. God is grieved when His people are lost!

Luke 13:34 *"O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, which killest the prophets, and stonest them that are sent unto thee; **how often would I have gathered** thy children together, as a hen doth gather her brood under her wings, **and ye would not!**"*


People wander away from God and deceive themselves by listening to false teachers. God desires for all to be saved, and has given His light to all men, enabling everyone to come to Him to be saved!

John 1:9-12 *"That was **the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.**" ¹⁰ He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. ¹¹ He came unto his own, and his own received him not. ¹² **But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.**"*

Noah could not save everyone, but his preaching saved his family!

12. NOAH TEACHES US TO WAIT FOR GOD, TO TRUST HIM, AND TO NOT BE MOVED BY WHAT WE SEE.

Genesis 8:1-7 “And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that was with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters assuaged; ²The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained; ³And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and fifty days the waters were abated. ⁴And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat. ⁵And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: in the tenth month, on the first day of the month, were the tops of the mountains seen. ⁶And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made: ⁷And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth.”



For the Bible to say God remembered Noah says what we all would feel if we were Noah, “What if God has forgotten us?” But God stopped the rain and flooding, and caused a wind to pass over the earth until it was dry. Noah had been in the darkness of the Ark for more than a year before he opened the window to look out and saw the ground was dry. Noah, his wife, his sons, their wives, and hundreds of animals, had waited upon the Lord. **God didn’t tell Noah they could come out of that dark place, Noah heard no word from God at all, so he trusted God and waited.** When I am in a dark place where I am not hearing from God, what should I do?

Proverbs 3:5-6 “Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths.”

Ephesians 6:13 “Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.”

Noah teaches us to trust God, and not be moved by what we see.

13. WAIT ON THE LORD UNTIL HE SAYS IT IS TIME.

Like the pitch on the Ark, be covered with Jesus inside and out, and pray fervently, doing all God puts in your heart to do. We can learn from Noah that when you have no word from the Lord, you don't lean on your own understanding and jump out because it seems the logical thing to do! If you have questions then go back to resting in the Lord in prayer, and wait to move until the answer is clear.

Genesis 8:13-19 *“And it came to pass **in the six hundredth and first year, in the first month, the first day of the month,** the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry. ¹⁴ And **in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month,** was the earth dried. ¹⁵ And God spake unto Noah, saying, ¹⁶ Go forth of the ark... ¹⁸ And Noah went forth, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him: ¹⁹ Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl ... after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.”*

Two full months passed after the ground looked dry before God said it was safe to come out of the ark! Only then did Noah and his family come out of the ark and travel down Mt. Ararat to start a new life.

Genesis 8:20-22 *“**And Noah** **built an altar unto the LORD;** and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar. ²¹ And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart is evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more everything living, as I have done. ²² **While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.**”*



The very first thing Noah did was to thank God! Couldn't Noah see that everything was gone? But Noah saw that he and his family were safe because of God's love and mercy! May we see with a heart of gratitude like Noah, even when everything looks barren!

14. NOAH OFFERED THANKS TO GOD, AND GOD GAVE THE RAINBOW AS THE SIGN OF HIS PROMISE.

Genesis 9:1-17 “And God blessed Noah and his sons, ... ⁸ And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying, ⁹ And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you... ¹³ I do set my bow in the cloud, and it



shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth. ¹⁴ And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud: ¹⁵ And I will remember my covenant, which is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh... ¹⁷ And God said unto Noah, This is the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that is upon the earth.”

Remember whenever you see a rainbow to wait on the Lord because He always keeps His promises, and keep your promise to Him!

Hebrews 12:1 “Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us.”



1 Corinthians 15:51-54 “Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, ⁵² In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. ⁵³ For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. ⁵⁴ So

when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.”

May we all be ready when Jesus comes to call His faithful ones to live forever with Him in Heaven, in glory of His presence!

15. GOD'S PURPOSE FOR ME



When you see a rainbow, remember it is a sign that Jesus loves you. He promises you salvation at His coming, and beauty in your life when you trust in Him. What keeps you from being obedient to God? Lay aside that weight that hinders you, and start living in the fullness of joy that Jesus promises for you when you follow Him!

1. God kept Noah safe in the Ark when the flood came, and Jesus will keep me safe in Him when the earth is cleansed by fire.
2. Strata of the earth formed in the year water covered the earth.
3. Dinosaur fossils and all fossils were preserved by sudden burial in sediment during the year of Noah's flood.
4. Jesus waits for to come to Him and be saved, just as He waited in the days of Noah, but the day will come when the door is shut.
5. Jesus' coming will be just as in the days of Noah, but with fire.
6. God's promise of salvation & immortality is for all who believe.
7. God always provides a way to keep us safe through our storms.
8. Noah teaches us to wait for God & not be moved by what we see.
9. A rainbow is the sign of God's promise not to destroy the earth.
10. All the promises God gave to Noah, He gives to me because I believe in Jesus and I belong to Him!


Jeremiah 31:3 "The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee."

Salvation is a covenant. With the same lovingkindness of long ago, Jesus draws all men unto Himself today. In Noah's day the sign of salvation received by faith was circumcision, while today the sign of salvation is baptism in Jesus' name.
