GOD'S PURPOSE FOR ME

I HAVE NO POWER TO WASH SIN'S STAIN
ONLY THE BLOOD OF JESUS CAN MAKE ME CLEAN

1. INTRODUCTION: Last week we saw the power of God poured out through Moses, in plagues upon Pharaoh and the Egyptians who chose to receive God's judgement by refusing to receive His grace. God showed His power to save those who trust in Him. Today, we will see how faith in the blood of the Lamb of God saves His people, and how God wants to work His mighty power through you.



2. WAITING AND TRUSTING GOD WHEN IT IS DARK

Could the Israelites trust their God to protect them? What must it have felt like to know that a judgement of death was about to fall? Would their children really be spared? How do you feel when violence or severe illness or unfairness threatens you? **There was no guarantee; they had to put all their faith in God and just trust Him in the darkness of that night no matter what.** They packed up to follow Jesus by faith, the same as we do!



***Proverbs 3:5-6** “Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. ⁶ In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.”*

Don't try to figure it out, just believe and trust God to direct your path, and He will. Moses kept proclaiming the name of God: I AM (YEHSHUA, JESUS) acknowledging Him, and God certainly did direct their path. The Israelites were going to have some large obstacles to face in the wilderness, but first they learned to trust God to deliver them from smaller things like pesky flies, building up their faith to trust Him in the more difficult things they would face ahead, the same way that God works in our lives.

***James 1:2-4** “My brethren, count it all joy when ye fall into divers temptations; ³ Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. ⁴ But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing.”*

Perfect, Strong's word #5046/5048 means to complete, and #2675 to complete thoroughly. God wants us to thoroughly complete our trust in Him so we will become perfectly complete in all His ways!

***Exodus 11:1** “And the LORD said unto Moses, Yet will I bring one plague more upon Pharaoh, and upon Egypt; afterwards he will let you go hence: when he shall let you go, he shall surely thrust you out hence altogether.”*

God makes a way to escape our enemies when there is no way!

3. GOD GIVES US GOLD THROUGH TRIALS BY FIRE



The Israelites were God's picture of what He will do in the last days before His coming. They were told to be watching and waiting for the call to escape the judgment of God that was to fall that night. Today, God's word tells us still, to be watching and waiting for the call to escape the judgment that will fall at Jesus' coming. Jesus provides a way of escape for His own! He wants us to be watching and ready for Him, and prepared to leave at any moment, because He is coming soon!

Exodus 11:2 *“Speak now in the ears of the people, and let every man borrow of his neighbour, and every woman of her neighbour, jewels of silver, and jewels of gold.”* (Show treasure chest of jewels.)



Revelation 3:17-18 *“Because thou sayest, I am rich, and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked: ¹⁸ I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and that the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.”*

God told Moses to have each family go to their Egyptian neighbors and ask them for gifts of gold and silver to take on their journey that night, and the Egyptians freely gave them. So how does this apply to us today? Jesus wants us prepared to let go of this world at a moment's notice, and come to Him to find the gold of real riches that will last well after we rise up to meet Him, and receive everything He has prepared in heaven for those who trust in Him.

James 4:8 *“Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.”*

Job 23:10 *“But he knoweth the way that I take: when he hath tried me, I shall come forth as gold.”*

4. ALL WHO WILL, CAN COME IN THE DOOR BY FAITH

From the first day that Moses appeared before Pharaoh, he told Pharaoh what God would do, if he refused to let God's people go.

*Exodus 4:22-23 "And thou shalt say unto Pharaoh, Thus saith the LORD, **Israel is my son, even my firstborn:** ²³ and I say unto thee, Let my son go, that he may serve me: and **if thou refuse to let him go, behold, I will slay thy son, even thy firstborn.**"*

Israel was called God's Son, because the Messiah yet to be begotten in Mary, who was foreordained to be born and crucified in the fullness of time, was carried in the bloodline of God's people Israel.

*1 Peter 1:19-20 "But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: ²⁰ who verily was **foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you.**"*

God knew the only way that Pharaoh would listen to Moses, was for God to show him through the death of Pharaoh's own firstborn son.

*Exodus 11:4-6 "And Moses said, Thus saith the LORD, About midnight will I go out into the midst of Egypt: ⁵ and **all the firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sitteth upon his throne, even unto the firstborn of the maidservant that is behind the mill; and all the firstborn of beasts.** ⁶ And there shall be a great cry throughout all the land of Egypt, such as there was none like it, nor shall be like it any more.*



God warned the wicked Egyptians before the coming of judgment, the same as He warned the wicked before the flood of Noah: to come in through the open door and be saved by faith. Jesus continues to warn the wicked today to come in through the door of Jesus by faith in the blood of the Lamb before the door of salvation is shut!

*Matthew 25:10 "And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and **they that were ready went in with him to the marriage: and the door was shut.**"*

5. PHARAOH CHOSE HIS OWN WAY AND DEFIED THE LIVING GOD OF HEAVEN LIKE MANY PEOPLE TODAY.

Pharaoh was like many today who refuse to listen and get so angry when they hear the word of God, and God knew Pharaoh's heart.

Exodus 11:9-10 “And the LORD said unto Moses, Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you; that my wonders may be multiplied in the land of Egypt. ¹⁰ And Moses and Aaron did all these wonders before Pharaoh: and the LORD hardened Pharaoh's heart, so that he would not let the children of Israel go out of his land.”

God hardened Pharaoh's heart **in the position he had chosen**. We can choose evil or **choose to believe and become elect for salvation**. Each must choose for themselves, though God knew before creation what each person will choose.



1 Peter 1:1-2 “Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ...² elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied.”

God chose Abraham to lead a people to carry the promised seed of Eve, to be born as Savior, so that by faith in Him, all may be saved.

1 Peter 2:9-10 “But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: ¹⁰ which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.”

2 Thessalonians 2:10-12 “...in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. ¹¹ And for this cause, God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: ¹² that they all might be damned who believed not the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness.”

You have the choice to listen to God and love Him because He loves you, and He wants to protect you like He protected the Israelites.

6. AFTER YEARS OF BONDAGE, GOD PROVIDES A WAY OF ESCAPE AND MAKES A NEW BEGINNING FOR US.

God not only called the day that He delivered His people from bondage by the blood of the Lamb, Passover, Nissan 15, a new beginning for His people, but God declared that month to be the beginning of months, so that Nissan 1, is the first day of the first month of the year for us, it was the first Happy New Year!



Exodus 12:1-6 “*And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in the land of Egypt, saying, ² **This month shall be unto you the beginning of months: it shall be the first month of the year to you.** ³ Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, **In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb,** according to the house of their fathers, a lamb for an house... ⁵ Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats: ⁶ and **ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month:** and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.”*



The Lamb the Israelites sacrificed was a substitute until God Himself came as the Lamb of God to become the sacrifice for sin.

John 1:29 “... John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, **Behold the Lamb of God,** which taketh away the sin of the world.”

But until then, each family was to take an innocent lamb into their home for four days, then the lamb had to die for their sins, and its blood applied to the doorpost of their house so the death angel would see the blood and pass over them. Jesus paid the penalty of death for us by shedding His blood on the cross so the penalty of 2nd death will pass over us. When we believe on Jesus and receive Him into our heart all things become new, Happy New Year!

2 Corinthians 5:17 “*Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.*”


7. OBJECT LESSON: Only the Blood of Jesus Can Make Me Clean

- Here is a jar of pure clean water. When Jesus comes into your heart through His Holy Spirit to be your Savior, He washes you clean and gives you His own righteousness. This is how clean your heart is when Jesus gives you His righteousness. What does that mean?



- Only Jesus never sinned and He is always right! Jesus does right-ness so we say **He is righteous**, and He completely washes your heart clean so that you are **righteous** too! But after a while, what happens to our beautiful pure clean heart? Sin! Sin is doing things that are not right so we call sin **un-right-ness or unrighteousness**. Our clean heart is like when you put on nice clean clothes after your bath, but then you go out and play...you come back a little dirtier than when you went out, don't you.

- Look at what happens when I put just a drop of sin into our glass of clean pure water. *(Put dark drop into the glass and stir.)* That tiny drop changed the whole glass of water!
- That is what happens when you choose to sin just a little. At first it seems like nothing will happen, but even a tiny bit of sin will make your whole heart dark with sin, *(say with sad voice)* so you will just feel blue.
- Let's see if soap will wash away this sin *(squirt a drop of dish liquid into jar and stir)*. No, it didn't work.



- *(Pour ½ cup of bleach into the jar)* Only bleach can bleach away the stain in this water, and only the blood of Jesus can take away the sin from your heart and make you clean and pure again!
- Did you notice that the blue stain didn't leave right away? It takes a little time for the bleach to completely cleanse the stain from this water, but in a little while it will.
- That is a picture of what happens when we confess our sins with faith that the blood of Jesus cleanses us from all our sins. Why do you still feel blue sometimes? Sometimes sins we have hidden, or sins that others have committed against us have left a stain in our heart, but **Jesus in your heart is able to search your heart and find all the blues! Only the blood of Jesus can wash us clean and take those blues away, and make us whole!**

8. THE PASSOVER IS A PICTURE OF THE LAST DAY, WHEN JUDGEMENT ‘SHALL ‘PASS OVER’ THOSE WHO TRUST IN JESUS, GOD’S ONLY AND FIRSTBORN, WHO SAID TO REMEMBER HIS DEATH, UNTIL HE COMES.

Exodus 12:7-14 “And they shall take of the blood, and strike it on the two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses, wherein they shall eat it. ⁸ And they shall eat the flesh in that night, roast with fire, and unleavened bread; and with bitter herbs they shall eat it... ¹² For I will pass through the land of Egypt this night, and will smite all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, both man and beast; and against all the gods of Egypt I will execute judgment: I am the LORD. ¹³ And the blood shall be to you for a token upon the houses where ye are: and when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and the plague shall not be upon you to destroy you, when I smite the land of Egypt. ¹⁴ And this day shall be unto you for a memorial; and ye shall keep it a feast to the LORD throughout your generations; ye shall keep it a feast by an ordinance for ever.”



Passover is remembering deliverance from bondage and death, and being led by a child to find the bread that was broken, wrapped in linen, then hidden and discovered! It is the life of the Son shared in glory with the Father, and His coming out from the Father while yet remaining in Him. Passover is the death burial and resurrection of our Lord! Jesus identified Himself as God in the Passover.

Luke 22:15-20 “And he said unto them, With desire I have desired to eat this passover with you before I suffer: ¹⁶ for I say unto you, I will not any more eat thereof, until it be fulfilled in the kingdom of God. ¹⁷ And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and said, Take this, and divide it among yourselves: ¹⁸ for I say unto you, I will not drink of the fruit of the vine, until the kingdom of God shall come. ¹⁹ And he took bread, and gave thanks, and brake it, and gave unto them, saying, This is my body which is given for you: this do in remembrance of me. ²⁰ Likewise also the cup after supper, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you.” Also quoted in 1 Corinthians 11:24-26

9. JESUS CAME AS THE PERSON OF GOD: GOD WITH US, HIMSELF THE SACRIFICE – THE BREAD OF HEAVEN!

What was the significance of eating the flesh of the Passover Lamb? Jesus explained to the Jews who asked Him for a sign from heaven, that HE is that manna and bread of the Passover that they should eat:

John 6:31-33,51,54-58 *“Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat. ³² Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven. ³³ For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world... ⁵¹ I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.... ⁵⁴ Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day... ⁵⁶ He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him. ⁵⁷ As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me. ⁵⁸ This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.”*



In every way God always seeks to bring life to those He created. Jesus longs to have each of us drink of His Spirit and eat of His living words that bring life for healing, recovery, and acceptance.

Luke 4:18-21 *“The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, ¹⁹ to preach the acceptable year of the Lord. ²⁰ And he closed the book, and he gave it again to the minister, and sat down. And the eyes of all them that were in the synagogue were fastened on him. ²¹ And he began to say unto them, This day is this scripture fulfilled in your ears.”*

10. PURGE ALL SIN AND PREPARE FOR DELIVERANCE!

The Israelites were to prepare for Passover by removing all leaven from their homes. Anyone who did not remove every trace of leaven from their home was cut off from the people because God was about to deliver the Israelites from their bondage. Jesus said leaven represents sin and false doctrine that puffs up our hearts. Not one bit of sin can be allowed to stay in our heart or home!

1 Corinthians 5:2-8 “*And ye are puffed up, and have not rather mourned, that he that hath done this deed might be taken away from among you.* ³ *For I verily, as absent in body, but present in spirit, have judged already, as though I were present,* concerning him that hath so done this deed, ⁴ *in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, with the power of our Lord Jesus Christ,* ⁵ *to deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus.* ⁶ *Your glorying is not good. Know ye not that a little leaven leaveneth the whole lump?* ⁷ *Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump,* as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us: ⁸ *therefore let us keep the feast,* not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth.”

Jesus commands us to repent of every sin, His blood cleanses us from all unrighteousness and His word is bread for us. God wants us to eat the word of God and always be ready to go where He leads.



Exodus 12:15-20 “*Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread;* even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that soul shall be cut off from Israel... ¹⁷ *And ye shall observe the feast of unleavened bread; for in this selfsame day I brought your armies out of the land of Egypt: therefore shall ye observe this day in your generations by an ordinance for ever...*”

What sin have I kept hidden? What area of my home and my heart must I completely surrender to Jesus so He can fully deliver me?

11. THE PEOPLE OBEY AND GOD KEEPS HIS WORD.

When the judgment for sin came, death passed over all who obediently purged their house of leaven and applied the blood of the Lamb. **There are many false teachers today** who say “To confess sin is an insult to God because Jesus died for your sins past, present and future!” **God’s word says these preachers are deceived and make God to be a liar!** God’s word further **confirms His eternal covenant cleanse our sin on an ongoing basis, including our continual need for repentance:**



1 John 1:6-10 “**If we say that we have fellowship with him, and walk in darkness, we lie, and do not the truth:** ⁷ **but if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.** ⁸ **If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.** ⁹ **If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.** ¹⁰ **If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.**”

When we keep our covenant to obey God and confess our sins, then God keeps His covenant to cleanse us by His blood that He shed once for all. All those who put their trust in God were safe, but the judgment of death came to the homes of those who would not trust God and be saved, so there was much weeping in Egypt.

Exodus 12:24-27 “**And ye shall observe this thing for an ordinance to thee and to thy sons for ever.** ²⁵ **And it shall come to pass, when ye be come to the land which the LORD will give you, according as he hath promised, that ye shall keep this service.** ²⁶ **And it shall come to pass, when your children shall say unto you, What mean ye by this service?** ²⁷ **that ye shall say, It is the sacrifice of the LORD’s passover,** who passed over the houses of the children of Israel in Egypt, when he smote the Egyptians, and delivered our houses. And the people bowed the head and worshipped.”

Our obedience to keep God’s covenant confirms our love for Him.

12. GOD SAVED THE ISRAELITES, AND HE IS COMING FOR ME, TO TAKE ME TO LIVE IN HEAVEN WITH HIM

Exodus 12:29-31 “And it came to pass, that at midnight the LORD smote all the firstborn in the land of Egypt, from the firstborn of Pharaoh that sat on his throne unto the firstborn of the captive that was in the dungeon ...**there was a great cry in Egypt; for there was not a house where there was not one dead.** ³¹ And he called for Moses and Aaron by night, and said, **Rise up, and get you forth from among my people... and go, serve the LORD, as ye have said.**”

Pharaoh and the Egyptians had refused to listen to God, to receive His grace and be saved from the final plague of death, and now Moses was gone, so there would be no more chances because the wages of sin is death! **Is it possible that a Christian could have to suffer judgement when Jesus comes?**


John 15:5-6 “I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. ⁶**If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.**”



1 Thessalonians 4:16-17 “For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and **the dead in Christ shall rise first:** ¹⁷ **then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.**”

Jesus is waiting with the Ark of the Promised Land of the Heavenly City prepared for you! He is coming to save all who trust in Him!

John 14:1-3 “Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me. ² In my Father’s house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. **I go to prepare a place for you.** ³ **And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.**”



13. GOD'S PURPOSE FOR YOU AND ME

1. We too have no guarantee: We must put all our faith in God and just trust Him in the darkness of difficult nights no matter what!
2. When I have to go through trials by fire, God gives me true riches, so I will come forth as pure gold.
3. Preach the Gospel to those who are lost and hurting so they may come safely to Jesus before the door of salvation is shut.
4. God wants us to love Him and obey His voice, so He can protect us in the time of judgement like He protected the Israelites.
5. No matter what our bondage, God wants to make us whole and give us a new beginning in our Lord Jesus Christ.
6. When God sees the blood of His Son applied by faith to my heart, the judgement of the second death will pass over me.
7. God showered bread from Heaven to feed the Israelites, and God showered His living word as bread from Heaven to feed me.
8. I can prepare for Jesus to deliver me and be ready for His coming, by purging every sin from my heart and from my home.
9. We are to continue to observe the cleansing of sins by Jesus' death on the cross, the Passover, forever as a perpetual covenant.
10. Remember who you are and your covenant with Jesus who is coming again. By abiding in His presence we will be ready to meet Him!



LET'S PRAY TOGETHER:

DIRECTIONS: Enlarge & Copy to white card stock. Cut out. Glue or write sin words on tiny bandaids and stick the bandaids on the dolls. Tell the children that as they confess their sins, to stick all the boo-boo sins to the cross and tell Jesus thank you for loving us so much that He died in our place so we can be forgiven!

15. CHILDREN'S STORY - "She'll Never Be Clean Again!"



Timmy had been Katie's very best friend, but since her birthday, Katie only loved her new Doll and didn't have time for Timmy anymore. One day when Katie went outside to play with her new doll, Timmy called her names, so Katie called him names right back! Later that afternoon, when Katie was playing outside, she heard the ice cream truck, and forgot all about her new doll sitting in the chair swing until she finished her ice cream. When Katie went back to check the swing, her new doll was gone! Katie told her mother and they went outside to look again. Katie could not believe her eyes! Her new doll was sitting in the swing with black marking pen smeared all over her face! Katie was so angry she cried; she knew who had done this awful thing! Mother took back into the house to try and clean the marking pen off the doll's face. Mother tried soap, and even toothpaste, but it didn't work. **Katie sobbed, "Oh mother, she'll never be clean again! I'll fix that Timmy!"** Katie's mother asked, "Katie, why would your friend Timmy do such a terrible thing?" Suddenly Katie understood. When she had gotten the new doll she was so happy, that she didn't play with Timmy anymore. Katie confessed her sin, "Mom, I'm so sorry, it's all my fault. I hurt Timmy's feelings and that's why he hurt my doll." Katie's mother understood and told her, "Katie, this terrible thing that happened to your doll reminds me of Jesus. Sometimes it is our own sin that hurts us, and sometimes we are hurt because others have sinned against us. Mother prayed with Katie that Jesus would show her what to do, and suddenly she remembered a spot remover that could take out marking ink – and it worked!
